PURPOSE:

This procedure outlines the steps for generating and reviewing the Epic upcoming surgical procedure report, in accordance with the Maximum Surgical Blood Order Schedule (MSBOS), to facilitate the preparation of blood and blood components for patients scheduled for surgery.

POLICY:

Using the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs report, a review and confirmation process will be implemented to verify blood availability for patients scheduled for surgery the following day,. This information will be provided by the Blood Bank to the OR the day before the surgery, indicating blood and patient specimen Availability and RBC antibody status. If blood is unavailable, the report will specify the specimen status and requirements, enabling necessary sample ordering and collection. The blood bank will maintain an up-to-date list of all patients scheduled for procedures in all operating rooms.

PROCEDURE / RESPONSIBLE:

- 1. The blood bank technologist will access and print the upcoming surgical procedure report in Epic for review of blood and patient specimen_availability at 3 pm daily. The Blood Bank staff will use the laboratory information system to perform a look up by accessing the patient's transfusion history by specific medical record number and name search to check if blood and or patient specimen is available.
- 2. The Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report is reviewed by specialty in accordance with the (MSBOS) and blood bank technologist, and indicate on the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report the following status requirements for the procedure:
 - a. Type and Screen (TS), when required.
 - b. Confirm Type (CT), when required.
 - c. Historical blood type, when available.
 - d. Number of blood products prepared as per the MSBOS.

Note: If the blood type is manually recorded in the T&S field and there are no indications for an additional specimen, blood will be prepared and made available according to the MSBOS.


- 3. When reviewing patient history in blood bank laboratory information system use name, medical record number (MRN), financial information number (FIN) and DOB as positive patient identifiers when performing a search.
- 4. Compare all patient's demographics on the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report (Patient's full name, DOB, and MRN when available) to the blood bank LIS. *Any discrepancy must be investigated*.
- 5. If patient has an active type and screen and ABO confirm, record the blood type and Rh result.
- 6. If patient requires ABO confirm, check that specific column.
- 7. If patient has no record of specimen, check that specific column.
- 8. If patient's history indicates atypical antibody(ies), check that specific column.
- 9. If the patient is computer crossmatch eligible, record "Yes" in the on-demand blood column.

- 10. Blood bank technologist must indicate on the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report and notify the clinical team if a sample(s) is needed for an In-house patient prior to surgery. The Blood Bank will notify the SDA/PST area when a Type & Screen (T&S) or ABO confirmation is needed, ensuring the specimen can be drawn upon the patient's arrival, prior to surgery. Document on the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report the name of the person notified.
- 11. Blood Bank technologist reviewing Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report must enter their name initials on the bottom of the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report when review is completed.
- 12. Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report is then reviewed by blood bank supervisor or designee for completeness and accuracy. Supervisor or designee must enter their name initials on the bottom of the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report when review is completed.
- 13. Upon completion, the final Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs report will then be distributed to all appropriate hospital areas, including OR, PST, ASU, and the Blood Bank.
- 14. Subsequent changes or updates in patient Blood Bank status are written on the-*final* copy and faxed to the OR by the end of the day.
- 15. The final Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report is posted in the Blood Bank visible for staff use.
- 16. Previous days' Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Reports are filed in a binder in date order and kept for one year in the Blood Bank.

PROCEDURAL NOTES:

- 1. Type and Screen sample must be reviewed to ensure sample is valid for date of procedure. If pre-surgical sample expiration date is incorrect, you must verify and update expiration date accordingly. Refer to Blood Bank Specimen Accessioning SOP.
- 2. When reviewing Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report, review must include all documented information that will aid in providing the appropriate blood products required (e.g., Preop Diagnosis, Patient on Anti-Platelet medication, clotting factor requirements, etc.).
- 3. Patients with current or historical antibody(ies) must have double the number of RBC units prepared as per the MSBOS (e.g., TS procedure will require a minimum of 2 units of RBC prepared, or MSBOS procedure requiring 2 units will need 4 units of RBC, etc.).
- 4. If a patient's clinical needs require additional blood components beyond the system-approved MSBOS guidelines, the case will be discussed with Blood Bank leadership and/or the Medical Director.
- 5. For patients with a directed donated unit, affix a "Directed Donation" sticker to the Upcoming OR Procedure and Blood Needs Report. Like wise, for patient's with an autologous unit, place the "Autologous Blood" sticker adjacent to that patient's name.
- 6. The 2,4,6-unit requirement is determined by integration of the Northwell MSBOS and the Epic software functionality.
- 7. Providers will place orders in Epic for the required products based on system approved MSBOS and/or determined patient's clinical needs.
- 8. After 3:00 p.m. (when the Blood Bank generates the final report), procedure cancellations and/or add-on cases, will be communicated to the Blood Bank.
