Title: BRCA Testing

Northwell Health Laboratories is pleased to announce the availability of improved BRCA testing for clinicians to order. The improved testing is indicated for patients with a potential genetic basis for cancer, including both breast and ovarian cancer.. Specifically we now offer a range of BRCA1 and BRCA2 tests. This ranges from Founder mutation testing in Ashkenazi Jews to broader next generation sequencing panels which include a variety of other genes (ie. PALB2 etc) that contribute to a patients risk for breast and ovarian cancer. These test methods ensure the highest detection rates of pathogenic mutations. Information of BRCA1 or BRCA2 status can impact the management of a patient and his/her family members. There are described management plans that are designed to decrease the morbidity and mortality within families who carry BRCA1 or BRCA2 mutations.

As with all genetic tests, there are many dedicated medical genetic specialists (ie. genetic counselors) who can offer genetic counseling.
